**Public Anniversary Recognition Policy**

It is the policy of the County of Warner No. 5 to recognize special events in the lives of County taxpayers by way of a plaque.

**Guidelines**

1. The County will recognize the following events in the lives of County ratepayers:
  - a. Wedding Anniversaries which include the 50<sup>th</sup>, 60<sup>th</sup>, 65<sup>th</sup>, 70<sup>th</sup>, 75<sup>th</sup> etc.
  - b. 100<sup>th</sup> Year Family Farm Anniversaries (farm shall be currently owned and operated by the immediate family or one of their direct descendants).
2. Written requests may be received from the affected County ratepayer or any other persons who are interested in the County ratepayer(s) being recognized.
3. Written requests should include the following:
  - a. Name of affected persons or family farm (with correct spellings), and
  - b. Type of anniversary with appropriate years.
4. Upon receiving the information, the County will prepare a recognition plaque with the County logo and the appropriate engraving on the plaque size as follows:
  - a. Wedding Anniversaries - 5" by 7", and
  - b. Family Farm 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversaries - 8" by 10".
5. The plaque will be distributed to the family by the County Councillor of the electoral division in which the ratepayer owns property. If this is not possible, Administration will distribute the plaques.
6. Any other kinds of anniversary recognitions being considered for presentation, need to be approved by County Council prior to the event.
