Vegetation Management

It is the policy of the Agricultural Service Board to prevent the establishment and/or spread of restricted and noxious weeds and develop sound vegetative management practices on all land within the County of Warner boundaries.

1. The purchase of herbicides for weed control programs will be made as per policy. Purchases shall be made through the AAMDC or the AAF if possible.
2. The Agricultural Service Board may accept applications for grants from Raymond Irrigation District, in regards to their weed control program, with provision that the Ag Fieldman makes pre-inspections of the area to be worked and a follow-up after work is completed and on approval of the Agricultural Service Board.
3. All weed notices to be issued by the Agricultural Fieldman. Notification of notices issued is to be provided to be provided to the chairman and affected Board members.
4. Action by the Agricultural Service Board is taken on all restricted weeds within the County to a satisfactory end. This action is to result in the implementation of control measures.
5. A weed inspector will be employed on a seasonal basis to assist the Ag Fieldman to enforce the Weed Control Act through extension and by issuing regular and blanket weed notices when required.
6. Develop special weed programs in cooperation with other government agencies, adjacent jurisdictions, industry and land owners for noxious and restricted weeds.
