Grass Control of County Roads and Trails

It is the policy of the County of Warner No. 5 Agricultural Service Board maintain summer trails/roads for travel through the use of herbicide treatment in order to control perennial and annual vegetation on the road right of way.

Guidelines

1. The Public Works Superintendent, at his discretion, and in consultation with adjacent landowners, will determine annually, the summer trails/roads which may be chemically treated within budget limits.
2. In consultation with the Public Works Superintendent, the Agricultural Fieldman will determine which herbicide is to be applied based on cost and control effectiveness, timing of the application, rate of application and cost per mile.
3. All costs associated with the chemical control shall be the responsibility of the Agricultural Service Board budget.
4. The chemical control will be applied on the road right of way, to a maximum width of thirty-three (33) feet. The width shall be determined by the Public Works Superintendent.
